Processional:

The ceremony begins with the entrance of the bridal party. Normally the ushers lead the procession, followed by the bridesmaids, maid/matron of honor, the ring bearer, and then the flower girl. The music selection should begin softly with the volume increasing gradually until it's time for the bride's entrance. Since the bride's entrance is the most important part of the processional, there will be an increase in volume when it's time for her to enter.
